



**OFFICIAL VISIT: PERMISSION TO HOST**

**COACHES:** This form is to be submitted to the Athletics Compliance Office. If approved, this form allows travel and lodging arrangements to be made for a prospective student-athlete to make an official visit to the University of Utah campus.

**NCAA Bylaw 13.6.2.2.2.1 PSAT, SAT, PLAN or ACT Score.** A member institution may not provide an expense-paid visit to a high school or preparatory school prospective student-athlete who has not presented the institution with a score from a PSAT, an SAT, a PLAN or an ACT test taken on a national testing date under national testing conditions, except that a state-administered ACT examination may be used to meet the requirement. The score must be presented through a testing agency document, on a high school (or college) academic transcript (official or unofficial) or through the use of the applicable testing agency's automated-voice system. A prospective student-athlete with a disability may present such a score from a special administration of the test (e.g., extended time). A foreign prospective student-athlete who requires a special administration of the PSAT, SAT, PLAN or ACT may present such a score upon the approval of the Academics/Eligibility/Compliance Cabinet or the Initial-Eligibility Waiver Committee. **NCAA Bylaw 13.6.2.2.2.2 Academic Transcript.** A member institution may not provide an expense-paid visit to a prospect who has not presented the institution with a high-school (or college) academic transcript. (Adopted: 1/16/93; Revised: 1/12/04 effective 8/1/04)
